

## ELIGIBILITY

Open to all Current IAA Members of the 2011-2012 year. **If you have any questions contact show chair.**

## ARTWORK REQUIREMENTS

Submitted works must have been completed within the last **2 years**, not accepted into a previous IAA Juried Membership show. All artwork must be **properly framed as required** or will be disqualified. Artwork must **not exceed 36" x 36" framed** nor heavier than 50lbs. Artwork **over 16" x 20" must be framed with plexi-glass** (exception pastels only). Screw-eyes or D rings wired for hanging only **NO Saw-tooth hangers. No clip on frames. NEW: Please string wire 1/3 down and tight across so wire will not be visible with our new hanging system.** Sculptures should not be over 50lbs and on a solid base not to exceed 10" circumference. Artwork must not be a series or part of a series (if a diptych or triptych it must be framed and entered as one piece and must not be larger than 36" x 36" framed). Computer generated and offset printed works are ineligible.

## ORIGINALITY OF WORK

Concept, design and execution of the artwork shall be solely that of the artist. No work copied from copyrighted or published materials. No images produced by drawing over digital reproductions allowed. No prints. No collaborations or copies of other artist's works.

**PERMISSION AND COPYRIGHT:** By submitting an entry, the artist grants permission for IAA to use the accepted image in it's newsletter, on it's website at [www.irvingart.org](http://www.irvingart.org), for brochures, promotional materials, catalogue, and publicity for this and future shows as well as for educational purposes.

The artist hereby certifies that he/she holds copyrights for the submitted artwork and the copyright remains with said Artist. The Artist also certifies that the work submitted is original and does not infringe on any existing copyright. If artwork includes image of person, artist certifies that a model release has been obtained. Irving Art Association reserves the right to reject any works not meeting



eligibility requirements, or deemed inappropriate to hang in the galleries at the Jaycee Park Center for the Arts, even after the image has been accepted.

## ENTRY FORMAT REQUIREMENTS

Digital Images **only** will be accepted (no slides or photos) Name each .jpg file with the artist's last name and first initial with entry number corresponding to entry number on the entry form.

**Example:** First name is Gorgeous, last name is Smiles:

SmilesG-1.jpg (for image #1),

SmilesG-2.jpg (for image #2),

SmilesG-3.jpg (for image #3).

Burn your .jpg files on a non-returnable CD with 300 pixels per inch resolution and a width and/or height maximum of 1800 pixels/6 inches. Only those digital images conforming to these specifications will be accepted. Images should show Only the work of art (no frame, easel or background). Images of accepted entries will become the property of IAA to be used for the catalogue and other printed material, archives, website and for educational purposes.

**Check or Money Order** in the amount of **\$35** for up to 3 entries should be **Made Payable To: Irving Art Association** with jpg files on CD, or entries and payment may be submitted online at [www.irvingart.org](http://www.irvingart.org), through our call for entries IAA 2012 Juried Members Show, payment made via Credit Card or PayPal. You may also enter online and pay by submitting a check. **Artwork mediums accepted in this show are the following categories:**

**1. Works on Canvas** - (Oil or Acrylic).

**2. Works on Paper** - (Water media).

**3. Mixed Media/Misc** - collage, calligraphy, hand-pulled prints or the use of two or more mediums. Collage must be only two-dimensional and incorporate only self-created elements (no photos).

**4. Drawing** - includes Pastel, Color Pencil, Graphite, Ink, Silver, Gold, Conté Crayon, scratchboard

**5. Photography/Sculpture** - No professional studio photos. Sculptures should be on sturdy flat base with a base circumference no larger than 10", under 50lbs.

(Categories with less than 7 accepted artists may be combined with another for award purposes only.)



## SELECTION AND AWARDS

Not all entries may be accepted into the show. Awards will be selected at the discretion of the juror. If unable to attend, please notify Show Chair as soon as possible at 972-254-5049 or [iaashow@irvingart.org](mailto:iaashow@irvingart.org). **Accepted work must remain on exhibit from May 1 – May 26, 2012. Winners must also be able to display their work at the IAC Focus Gallery IAA Winners Exhibit June 2 to July 8, 2012.**

## FRAMING

Artwork must be framed and wired with screw eyes or D rings and wire should be approximately 1/3 down and strung tightly straight across (due to new hanging system) ready to hang. **No Sawtooth Hangers.** ALL works on paper larger than 16" x 20" must be under **Plexiglas, with the exception of pastels.** Wrap around canvas at least 1.5" deep may be submitted, no staples showing and painted on all sides. Paintings with loose or damaged frames will not be accepted. Keep the frame simple and lightweight.

**Failure to comply with any of the above stipulations will result in your artwork being disqualified.**

## SALES

All sales must be arranged between IAA and buyer. A commission of 10% for work sold during the show is payable at the end of the show. The artist is liable for all taxes and commissions on these sales. **Sold artworks cannot be removed until the end of the show.**

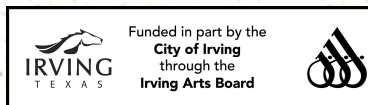
## LIABILITIES

## Juror: Dave Kramer

IAA is proud to have Dave Kramer as the juror for our 57th Annual Juried Members Show. Dave grew up in La Porte, IN., studied fine art at Indiana University and,

while a student, painted illustrations for several design studios. In 1985, moved to Dallas, Tx. and embarked upon a career as a freelance illustrator. He now is doing what he truly loves painting art and portraits in a Romantic or Iconic Realism style. Inspired by such artists as John William Waterhouse, John Singer Sargent and Adolphe-William Bouguereau, Dave paints portraits that go beyond a realistic likeness of the subject to a valuable piece of fine art. Dave teaches at the Creative Art Center of Dallas, a non-profit art school.

Dave was the 2010 Pet Show juror and generously gave a well-received talk following the Awards Reception. He will be teaching a 4—evening workshop on Color Theory.

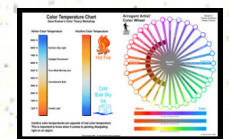
