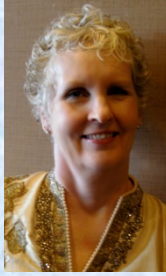


## Juror

Chris Fulmer is a graduate of North Texas State University (MA in art history), Trinity University (BA in art and English), and the University of Texas (BFA in Art Education). She also has accumulated a substantial amount of graduate studio hours from Texas Tech University. She is a professor of art at North Lake College. Past experiences include: consultant for Binney & Smith, public school art educator, and curriculum development for Laguna Gloria Museum.



As an artist, Chris creates mixed media work on paper and panel, often including three-dimensional objects and areas of texture, she executes thematic works dealing with literature, symbolism, or personal experiences. Her award winning work has appeared internationally, nationally, and locally in a variety of shows and juried exhibitions. Her work is also included in corporate and commercial collections

What Canst Thou Say, and Artist's Magazine have published her writing and illustrations. A thirty-minute documentary was produced and televised by Irving Community Television Network. Most recently she has designed the DART light rail train station at North Lake College.

## Eligibility

Any member of the IAA in good standing as of January 31, 2010 is eligible to enter. All entries must be original and completed in the last 2 years.

## Categories:

- Oil, acrylic on canvas
- Water media
- Drawing media & hand-pulled prints
- Mixed media, collage
- Photography, sculpture

## Framing

Artwork must be framed and wired with screw eyes or D-rings ready to hang. No saw tooth hangers accepted. All works on paper must be under Plexiglas, if over 16"x20", except for pastels, which may be under glass. 1.5" deep wraparound canvas may be submitted, no staples showing and all sides painted. Size limit is 36"x36"

## 3-Dimensional Artwork

Artwork must be of wood or metal and not exceed 50 lbs. and exceed 36" in any direction and must be on a flat sturdy stand.

## Digital Images

Only digital images will be accepted (no slides). JPG files should be no larger than 1.5 MB, at least 300 pixels resolution and a width of and/ or height maximum of 1800 pixels/ 6 inches. Images should show only the artwork (no frame, easel or background). Accepted images will become the property of IAA to be used for the catalogue and other printed material, archives, website and for educational purposes.

Only those images conforming to these specifications will be accepted. Each artist may submit up to 3 works of art. Entries may be submitted online at

Works must be available from  
Saturday April 24 – Friday May 27, 2010

### Friday, March 26, 2010

Deadline for submitting online entry form and \$35 PayPal payment; or receipt of mailed entry form and \$35 entry fee check (Nonrefundable).

### Wednesday, March 31, 2010

All entries sent to juror for show selection.

### Friday, April 16, 2010

Notification of acceptance mailed or emailed to entrants.

### Saturday, April 24, 2010

Selected artwork will be delivered to the Jaycee Park Center for the Arts 2000 W. Airport Freeway, Irving TX from 10AM-2PM. Entries arriving after the deadline will not be accepted.

### Sunday, April 25, 2010

Show opens.

### Sunday, May 2, 2010

Reception and awards presentations will be held at the Jaycee Park Center for the Arts from 2PM – 4PM. If unable to attend please notify Brenda Mattioli at 972 717 7606

### Friday, May 28, 2010

Pick up your artwork from 10AM-2PM at the Jaycee Park Center for the Arts. Artwork left past this date will be fined \$10 per day storage fee.

Winners are to take their winning artwork to the Irving Art Center for a show in the Focus Gallery.

## Entry Checklist

- Each jpg image file corresponds to entry form number and is correctly labeled with the artist's **last name** and **first initial**. Example Smith, A1 for image #1, Smith, A2 for image#2, Smith A3 for image #3.
- Complete all information on the entry form either online or by mail. Print clearly and sign entry form. No post office boxes please. Incorrectly labeled images and incomplete documentation will result in rejection of all artwork submitted.
- Notification will be emailed. If you prefer send a #10 self-addressed stamped envelope for the return of notification by USPS. CD will not be returned.
